Why to visit Bratislava?

During the Austro-Hungarian monarchy, when Bratislava called „ Prešporok“ was one of the most important cities in monarchy. Also Maria Theresia II. was crowned in Bratislava in St. Martin´s Cathedral. In this Gothic church between 1563 – 1830 were crowned 11 Hungarian kings and 8 consorts. The historical center is just the right size for every sight to be accessible on foot. When strolling through the streets of Bratislava the unique atmosphere of the city will grow on you. There is nothing quite like a romantic walk from the Bratislava castle, down the stairs to the main square, through the picturesque narrow streets, around the majestic fortification walls, the beautiful Cathedrals and passing by countless original, modern and vintage cafes, restaurants, wine bars and pubs that cater for all tastes and styles.

What to see / what to do:

* St. Martin´s Cathedral * Primatial Palace houses a unique series of six English tapestries from the 17th century, the Treaty of Pressburg between France and Austria was signed here in 1805 after the Battle of Austerlitz * Main square with Old Town Hall * St. Michael´s Gate * Franciscan church and monastery from year 1297 * Bratislava Castle * Grassalkovich Palace * Devín Castle and Sandberg * Mausoleum of Chatam Sofer * museums and galleries * boat trips to Vienna, Devin and Gabčíkovo * water sports area Čuňovo * city beach * roast goose gaudies in Slovensky Grob * Small Carpathian´s wine trip * Bratislava Music Festival * Culture summer time * Junifest Beer Fest * Bratislava Jazz Days * Coronation celebration * Danube riverside * Shakespeare Days and more others ...

Bratislava´s curiosities:

Rubberneck – no other city in the world has a statue sticking out of a manhole * Taunter is a strange figure * Schone Náci /statue/ was a real part of the Bratislava local colour * The Narrowest house in Central Europe – the front facade is only 130 cm wide * Korzo is the name of a pedestrian zone which runs through the heart of city centre * The well without water – the well diggers were stopped by a 320 cm thick granite slab * Napoleon´s soldier statue * Paparazzi and many others...
